

Meeting of the Local Governing Body of Stoke Park Primary School

Information to parents:

Governors discussed:

- The excellent provision of remote learning at Stoke Park and how well the staff team continue to support children both at home and at school.
- The impact of fundraising and donations on the school's ability to support children with learning at home.
- Changes to the school site that might be possible when students from Trinity are able to move into their new building (expected after September 2021) and to improve the heating system.

Governors decided:

- To approve admissions arrangements for 2022/23 based on the outcome of the consultation by CST.
- To approve the annual review of the school's statutory policies on First aid and Supporting pupils with medical conditions
- That there is no intention to use biometrics at the school at present.

Governors are going to:

- Write a letter of thanks to the school's benefactor in recognition of the impact of their donation on children's learning.
- Help the school to review its E-safety and communication Policy and Relationships and Sex Education Policy.
