Information for parents:

Governors discussed

- The high level of impact that the COVID pandemic is currently having on the school.
- The work of the School Council over the last 6 months to incentivise improvements in playground and wider school behaviour and to develop a new sports league for the school.
- The outcomes of the Governor skill's audit.
- Early draft areas of focus for the new School Development Plan which are formulating around high-quality teaching, school culture and the school environment.

Governors decided

- New terms of reference for the Curriculum, Achievement and Teaching Committee and committee membership for 2021-22.
- To set up a working group to create a strategy for strengthening school governance.
- Dates of Governor meetings for the coming academic year and the appointment of the Chair to Governors and Vice Chair to Governors for 2021-22.

Governors are going to

- Introduce a new series of Governor awards for children based around the school values and priorities for improvement.
- Improve communication of the role of Governors to parents and carers of the school by creating a flier to explain the role of governors in the running of the school and arranging a 'meet the governors' event.
- Raise with local councillors their concerns for on-street parking, road safety and the impact on residents should the planning application to retain the school car park be turned down.
