

Meeting of the Local Governing Body of Stoke Park Primary School

20.05.2021

Information to parents:

Governors discussed

- The anticipated overspend of the school budget in 2021-22 to fund additional staff to support the school's recovery post COVID. The school has ample reserves to cover this expenditure.
- The substantial levels of maintenance and building works that will be occurring across the school site over the summer break (including the removal of portacabins, new windows, repairs to the hall floor and new IT boards in every classroom). Combined with the fact that every class will be relocating classroom before children return to school a change of start date for the 2021-22 academic year was proposed.

Governors decided

- To approve the school budget for the next 3 years in principle (pending approval by CST trustees).
- To approve the school's new Early Years and Foundation Stage Policy – this will be available to parents on the school website.

Governors are going to

- Ask the school to propose plans for a new or revitalised staffroom.
 - Include incorporate 'the Child's voice' into monitoring visits to the school
- Undertake an audit of the skills of the Local Governing Body and review school governance with the support of Geoff Mountjoy from CST central team.
